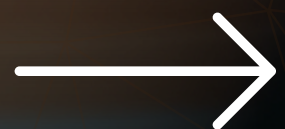




THE IDEA FOR OPENSTACK CONTRIBUTION CAMP STARTED IN SA PA, VIETNAM 2023

During that brief meeting, Ary shared his desire to bring a mentorship program to Indonesia, inspired by a similar initiative that the OpenInfra Korea User Group had successfully implemented.

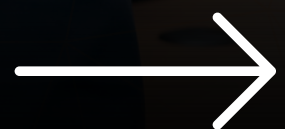




NOT JUST PRESENT, BUT ALSO ACTIVELY CONTRIBUTING.

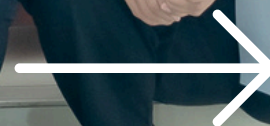
BY THE COMMUNITY, FOR THE COMMUNITY, SUPPORTED BY ALL PARTIES.

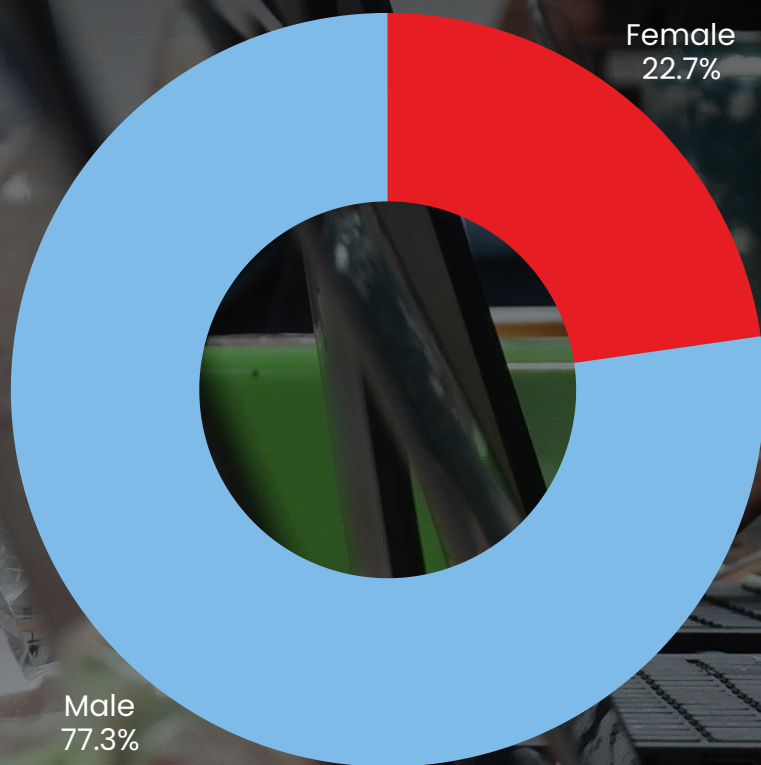

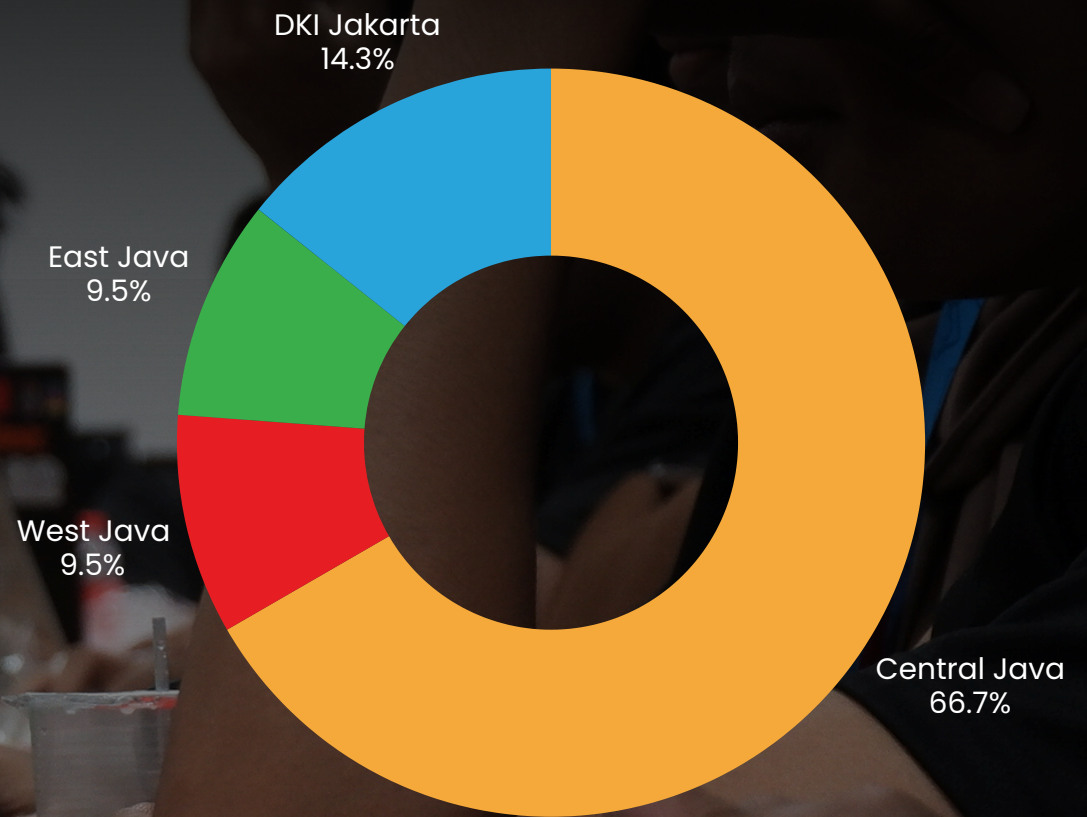

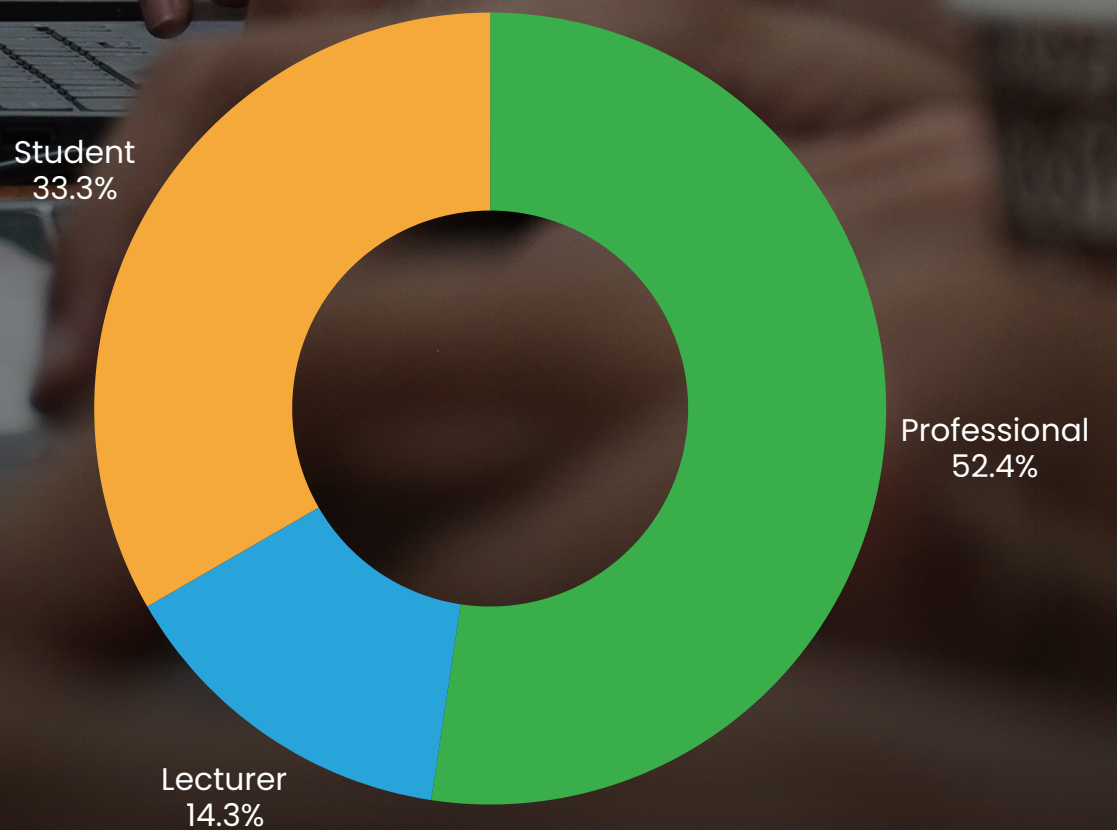
